ANNUAL REPORT SUBMITTED AT THE 9TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE SRI LANKA BELGIUM ASSOCIATION HELD ON 15TH MAY 2015 AT AMARADASA GUNAWARDANA AUDITORIUM AT SRI LANKA COUNCIL FOR THE BLIND HEADQUARTERS, SARANA MAWATHA, RAJAGIRIYA.

On behalf of the Executive Committee of the Sri Lanka Belgium Association we are pleased to present the Annual Report for the year 2014/2015.

INTRODUCTION

It was on 19th August 2003 that we, who were in Sri Lanka China Society, formed Sri Lanka Belgium Association with the friendly guidance from Mr. Dayasiri Fernando. It was he who introduced us to late Mr.Gaston Dillen of Adoptie Sri Lanka. We in SLBA were dragged into the field of community development by him. Since the year 2000 we are active in that field with personal guidance from Mr.John Van Dijck of Adoptie Sri Lanka.

MEMBERSHIP

The membership of the SLBA which was recorded at the last AGM as 45 has now increased to 49.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETINGS

Since the last AGM held on 23rd October, 2013 we had held nine Executive Committee Meetings. Six meetings were held at the CNAPT center, Colombo 07 and the last three meetings were held at Sri Lanka Council for the Blind Headquarters, No.50/B, Sarana Mawatha, and Rajagiriya. SLBA is thankful to the Sri Lanka Council for the Blind for making available the auditorium for meetings of SLBA free of charge.

SLBA PROJECTS

Following projects are continuing satisfactorily with the financial assistance received from Adoptie Sri Lanka Belgium. Programmes were aimed at combating disability, promoting and improving health and education of the school children and elders in order to enhance their quality of life.

WANAMEEKANDA

The activities that the SLBA started in the year 2000 are continuing with additional facilities. Two lady instructors manage the pre-school which has at present 39 children. They are supplied with school uniforms, books and stationary and mid-day meal.

In addition there is also a

scholarship scheme where the past students of the pre-school and other students selected from Wanameekanda

And adjoining villages totaling 169 are given monthly financial assistance to meet their educational expenses .Some committee members visited Wanameekanda on several occasions to make the payments to the scholarship holders

and to hand over books and stationary and also to attend new year celebrations by the students. During the period funds were also provided for the construction work of the kitchen extension and electrical rewiring.

Mr. and Mrs. Van Dijck along with some Committee members visited Wanameekanda on 19th January 2015 where they participated at the annual concert by students of the pre-school and also distributed spectacles for 50 villagers selected under the project.

> THUNTHALAWA

This is a remote village which had been developed in stages with the funds provided by Adoptie Sri Lanka VZW. Some of the projects funded by Adoptie Sri Lanka are the drinking water supply scheme

to the village, providing a building and other related items to the pre-school and houses with sanitary facilities for the needy families in the village. Presently 18 children attend the pre-school and they are provided with school uniforms, school bags, books, stationary and also mid-day meal.
